

DEPARTMENT 7 – POULTRY

Show Order will follow fair book
See Department 10, Division A for more opportunities

RULES:

1. All State of Wisconsin mandatory health regulations apply. See "Animal Health Rules & Regulations – Wisconsin Fairs & Shows" page 6.
2. All Pullorum testing must be done within 90 days – 2 days before the animals are brought to the current year's fair.
3. All birds need to be in possession of the youth exhibitor before May 15th of the current year to be eligible for exhibit.
4. All poultry exhibits must be the work of the exhibitor and/or their family.
5. Members are to list the breed of poultry on Entry Form in Fair Entry.
 - a. When making an entry, list each bird separately. Only one entry per lot, this includes color.
 - b. **Birds may NOT be changed at the fair if entered incorrectly. If unsure of placement, call the Superintendent.**
 - c. Entrants can use the American Standard of Perfection by the American Poultry Association (<http://amerpoultryassn.com/>) for classification.
 - d. **Division G – ALL OTHER STANDARD BREEDS Miscellaneous is for pure bred birds that have not been admitted into the APA book of Standard.**
 - e. Frizzles will be shown in their respective breed and variety class.
6. Definitions
 - a. Cockerel, Pullet or Young Bird - hatched on or after January 1 of the current year.
 - b. Cock, Hen or Old Bird - hatched prior to January 1 of the current year
7. Exhibitor must bring 2 sets of paperwork (original certificate and a copy) with their birds on entry day, stating birds are NPIP, NPIP Affiliate, WI Tested Flock, WI Associate Flock. If your birds were acquired from an NPIP source and they are the only birds on the premises, you will need a WI Associate Flock Certificate; **a receipt of sale cannot be used as proof of testing. Copies cannot be made in the fair office.**
8. All poultry must be in full feather and 4 months of age or older. If you are not showing it, PLEASE don't bring it.
9. **All poultry will be health checked upon entry. Any birds found to have parasites or show signs of illness may not be shown.**
10. If a conflict of animal showtime occurs, all substitute showmen must go through the Superintendent. They must be siblings, other poultry members, or other 4-H, FFA or youth members.
11. Only the Youth Exhibitor will stand in the Judge's presence with the Superintendent or Clerk. All others need to stand away. Please don't interrupt the Judge with questions or comments until asked for.
12. **CARE OF POULTRY IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE EXHIBITOR**
 - a. **Poultry should be fed and watered twice a day**
 - b. **Cages will be cleaned daily with fresh shavings**
 - c. **Exhibitor must furnish Feed and Water Dishes, they must be appropriate to the size of the bird, NO PAPER CUPS OR CUT OFF PLASTIC BOTTLES.**
13. Poultry is released on Sunday at 4pm.

Division A – SHOWMANSHIP

RULES:

1. All poultry exhibits, including pigeons, are eligible for showmanship.
2. Registration required on Entry Form in Fair Entry.
 - a. Grade levels for showmanship classes determined as of January 1 of current calendar year.
3. **Exhibitors must show their own animal in Showmanship Classes.**

3. Must be all one color.
