

DEPARTMENT 8 – RABBITS

RULES

1. All State of Wisconsin mandatory health regulations apply. See “Animal Health Rules & Regulations – Wisconsin Fairs & Shows” page 6.
2. If at any time an animal shows evidence of contagious or infectious disease, it shall be removed from the exhibit as per the direction of the supervising veterinarian. Animals can only be removed from premises under permit from the Department of Agriculture or Supervising Veterinarian.
3. Members are to list the breed of rabbit on Entry Form in Fair Entry.
 - a. All age and weight specifications as used by the American Rabbit Breeders Association (<https://arba.net/>) will be strictly adhered to.
 - b. Rabbits incorrectly entered by sex or breed are disqualified.
4. If exhibitors cannot be present to show their rabbit, they must contact the superintendent to make arrangements.
5. Rabbits that are uncontrollable when being handled, not accustomed to being caged, or not tame, will not be admitted for exhibition.
6. Show Order will be posted by the Superintendent.

Division A - Showmanship

RULES:

1. Registration required on Entry Form in Fair Entry.
 - a. Grade levels for showmanship classes determined as of January 1 of the current calendar year.
2. **Exhibitors must show their own animal in Showmanship Classes.**

Division T – Homebred & Raised Rabbits

Rules:

1. The Homebred & Raised Class is designed for those exhibitors who have bred and raised their own litters.
2. Exhibitors may show one rabbit in each age classification.
3. Rabbits being exhibited in the “under 6 months” class **MUST** be a minimum of 8 weeks of age.
4. Rabbits being exhibited in the “over 6 months” class do not have an age limit, but must be over the age of 6 months.
5. Each rabbit will be judged based on its breed standard.
6. Awards will be given to the top animal in each class.
