### Division A – Cut Flowers

- RULES: 1. Painted tin cans or cans covered with foil recommended.  
 2. Cut flowers must be grown by exhibitor.  
 3. Three spikes or blooms required per entry (unless noted).  
 4. Do not strip all leaves from stem.  
 5. No silk flowers/plants.  
 6. For poster regulations, see Rules & Regulations Junior Division.  
 7. **No Glass unless specifically noted.**
