2026 RULES and REGULATIONS FARM TRACTORS and HOT FARM TRACTORS THURSDAY, JULY 30th, 2026 – 7:00 PM SHARP

FARM TRACTORS

Entry Fee: \$25.00 per tractor

Weigh-in: 3:00 – 6:00 PM. Scale will close at 6:00 PM SHARP – NO EXCEPTIONS
Winnebago County Fair Grounds (AKA Sunnyview Exposition Center)
500 County Road Y, Oshkosh WI. / Enter the Pit area off of State Highway 76.

Each tractor may pull once – no jumping of classes. The same driver may enter multiple tractors.

Farm Classes:

Class A	6,500 lbs.	Turbo and/or Non-Turbo – Paced at 4 mph
Class B	8,500 lbs.	Turbo and/or Non-Turbo – Paced at 4 mph
Class C	10,500 lbs.	Turbo and/or Non-Turbo – Paced at 5 mph
Class D	12,500 lbs.	Turbo and/or Non-Turbo – Paced at 5 mph
Class E	14,000 lbs.	Turbo and/or Non-Turbo – Paced at 8 mph
Class F	17,000 lbs.	Turbo and/or Non-Turbo – Paced at 8 mph
Class G	22,000 lbs.	4 Wheel Drive / No dual wheels allowed – No Pace
Class H	28,000 lbs.	4 Wheel Drive / Dual wheels allowed – No Pace

Farm Class Rules:

1. Tractors in Class A must be 1960 or newer if from outside of Winnebago County WI
2. Stock RPM in all farm classes
3. No cut or modified tires in any farm classes
4. Maximum tires size of 18.4x38 in classes A and B
5. 20-inch maximum drawbar height in classes A, B, C, D, E or F / Must be ridged in all directions
 - a. At least 18 inches from center of rear axle to hook point
6. 21-inch maximum drawbar height in classes G or H / Must be ridged in all directions
7. No weights allowed in the 3-point hitch of any 4-wheel drive tractor
8. All Farm Tractor Class Tractors must be equipped with a clevis or pulling eye
9. Farm class tractors must have a working PTO and hydraulics. No turbo larger than 2.3" inlet
10. No nitrous, alcohol or ether allowed – Stock fuel only
11. No water injection in farm classes
12. Weights may not extend more than 24 inches in front of the tractor casting (frame). Rear weights may stick back a reasonable distance but cannot interfere with hooking to the weight transfer sled. Weights must be securely fastened.

6,500 lb. Box Turbo (Class I) / No Pace

1. Naturally aspirated engines limited to 650 cu. In. Turbo engines limited to 2 valve heads and 365 cu. In.
2. Box Turbo – Borg Warner S300SX-E 2.46 inlet – turbo must be sealed / Electronic Fuel Injection not permitted
3. Tires: 18.4x38 maximum / any cut tires allowed / Safety equipment required:

7,800 lb. (Class J) / No Pace

5. 3,200 rpm maximum. Hot Farm Class tractors will be plugged into the Eliminator to monitor RPM's. Tractor must have an accessible plug at the back of the tractor. Plug must be female
6. Tires: 18.4x38 maximum / no cut tires allowed
7. Turbo inlet – 2.4 inch maximum / Cubic Inches – 329 maximum
8. Safety equipment required: Air shut off system, Wheelie Bars and Cross Bolt in exhaust pipe

9,500 lb. (Class K) / No Pace

1. 3,000 rpm maximum. Hot Farm Class tractors will be plugged into the Eliminator to monitor RPM's. Tractor must have an accessible plug at the back of the tractor. Plug must be female.
2. Tires: Top and/or front cut tires allowed
3. Turbo inlet – 3 inch maximum / Cubic inches – 466 maximum / No intercooler / Water injection OK
4. Safety equipment required: Air shut off system, Wheelie Bars and Cross Bolt in exhaust pipe

9,000 lb. – 9 mph Pace and 13,500 lb. – 10 mph Pace (Classes M and L)

1. 3,000 rpm maximum / No plug in required
2. Tires: Top cut tires allowed / No front cuts
 - **9,000 lb.** – 18.4 x 38 tires maximum / **13,500 lb.** – 42 diameter tire maximum
3. Factory fuel only – no secondary fuels or additives / water injection ok / P pump ok
4. Any size Turbo OK / Single Turbo only
5. 13,500 lb. - No modified or lowered front axles

Additional Hot Farm Class Rules: (Classes I, J, K, L and M)

1. Weights may not extend more than 24 inches in front of the tractor casting (frame). Rear weights may stick back a reasonable distance but cannot interfere with hooking to the weight transfer sled. Weights must be securely fastened.
2. Drawbar Height: 20 inches in all Hot Farm Classes / Ridged in all directions
3. Tractors must be equipped with a clevis or pulling eye
4. No nitrous, alcohol or ether allowed / Stock fuel only
